Since 1984, BiCon has been the UK's main annual event for bisexuals, their friends and supporters

In 2011 BiCon will return to the University of Leicester, following its success there in 2008.

During the day there will be a variety of activities including discussion groups and sessions on a variety of topics, as well as free form craft spaces and areas for hanging out and socialising.

In the evening, there are entertainments, social space and a bar, as well as guieter spaces for games and chill-out.

Although we welcome non-residential bookings from people who live nearby or who wish to arrange their own accommodation, most people stay on site. BiCon 2011 is a self catered event, with two types of accommodation available. Standard rooms will be in corridors of 6 or 7 single bedrooms sharing two bathrooms – two corridors (about 13 people) share a small kitchen. En suite rooms have their own bathrooms, and are in flats of 6 single bedrooms sharing a larger kitchen / dining room more suited for socialising.

BiCon is a not-for-profit volunteer-run event and aims to be accessible to anyone who would like to attend. The venue is fully wheelchair accessible with adapted bedrooms on the ground floor, or accessible by lift, available on request. There are also one day passes and all bookings are upgradeable (non-residential up to and during BiCon), so if you change your mind and want to stay longer, you can.
